Charter Standard Club

Wrekin Juniors achieved Charter Standard status in March of this year - it demonstrates to parents and children that the club has achieved the required standards of provision as laid down by the FA.

This season we are following the FA Respect Programme which is to make football enjoyable for everyone and for players, parents and officials to follow a code of conduct to make sure that it is.

In every pack that our players received before the new season the conduct is clearly laid out. It states that we will not tolerate swearing, abuse of officials and we expect everyone to treat others as they would want to be treated.

On average, 7,000 referees quit football every year because of the abuse they receive from players and from the sidelines. Lots of children also pack in playing because of the attitude and actions of over-enthusiastic and pushy parents.

Please read our Codes of Conduct and make sure you adhere to them – but most of all enjoy the football (players and parents alike).

The FA are coming down hard on clubs who behave badly – Wrekin Juniors are proud to have achieved Charter Standard status and do not want it taken off us.
